

CHILD TRANSPORT POLICY

Purpose:

To ensure the safety of children and the driver during transport before, after or during attendance at a Treetops ELC centre by a Treetops ELC staff member and/or in a Treetops ELC vehicle.

Guidelines:

- 1. Parental permission must be obtained prior to any child being transported unless it is a medical or civil defense emergency.
- 2. Any vehicle used to transport tamariki must have at least two adults who have been safety checked in the vehicle.,
- 3. A signed consent form must have the names of the staff who are authorised by the parent/guardian to collect or drop off Tamariki. Only staff members who have parental authorisation are able to transport tamariki at any time.
- 4. Tamariki must not be seated in the front seat of the car if there is an airbag unless they are over 148cm tall.
- 5. Tamariki must remain seated at all times while the vehicle is turned on and must be restrained in a safety approved over the shoulder restraint as required by clause 7.6 of the Land Transport (road user) Rule 2004.
- 6. Tamariki must not be left alone in the vehicle at any time.
- 7. Only drivers holding a current full driving license will be permitted to transport tamariki.
- 8. All vehicles must carry a stocked first aid kit.
- 9. The driver must have a mobile phone and access to contact details and emergency contact details for all tamariki being transported.
- 10. It is the responsibility of the CM to ensure that any work vehicles for their centre are properly maintained, serviced and kept in a clean and tidy condition.

If the vehicle is involved in an accident:

- Ensure tamariki are safe and not hurt
- Seek medical advice/call 111 if required
- If another driver is involved, collect the following information (once it has been confirmed all tamariki are safe and unhurt)
 - Name, phone number and address of the owner
 - Vehicle type
 - Vehicle registration
 - Insurance company
 - If they admit fault, record precise words
 - Name, phone number of any witnesses
 - Report to your CM, who will inform CD immediately.
