

LAUNDERING

Purpose:

At Treetops Early Learning Centre, we are committed to upholding the health and wellbeing of children by ensuring linen is laundered in hygienically, cultural and respectful way

Policy:

- 1. All Children will have their own linen washed on a weekly basis unless required more frequently.
- 2. Linen will be stored in named bags when not on beds.
- **3.** Linen can either be washed in the centre washing machine using laundry detergent and hot water or off site at an approved laundry service provider.
- 4. Linen will be dried in the dryer or the washing line or off site.
- 5. Soiled linen will be soaked in appropriate disinfectant, i.e Germex before being washed in the washing machine.
- 6. Tikanga Maori will be practiced and staff will receive training in this area if unsure.
- 7. The following will be washed together:
 - Tea towels, kitchen cloth (green or lilac) table cloths
 - Bedding, body towels (items used below the shoulders)
 - Pillowcases, bibs, face cloths (items used above the shoulders)
 - Yellow cloths (general), blue cloths (art) general purpose towels
 - Pink cloths (bathroom)
- **8.** Coloured cloths should be placed in separate containers while waiting to be washed.
- 9. Items above shoulders should not be washed with items below shoulders.
- **10.** Linen will be stored hygienically when not in use
