| <input type="checkbox"/> Washable Paints & Brushes | Include large-handled brushes and thick tempera paints. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Stickers | Easy to peel and stick for independent creativity. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Glue & Adhesives | Glue sticks and liquid glue in small bottles for early gluing practice. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Craft Papers | Construction paper, tissue paper, and pre-cut shapes. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Natural Materials | Leaves, sticks, shells, and stones for nature-based crafts. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Large Beads & Pipe Cleaners | Large beads and bendable pipe cleaners for threading and shaping. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Foam Shapes or Sheets | Easy to cut and stick, ideal for collages. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Large Stamps & Ink Pads | Foam or rubber stamps with washable ink pads. |
